Heating System (Forced Air Gas)

These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.

This inspection is designed to increase efficiencies and reduce potential fire hazards. Always consult your owner's manual for detailed maintenance and operations instructions.

1. Remove and inspect the filter. If the filter is dirty, clean or replace it. (Some units have re-useable filters that can be cleaned with mild soap, water and a brush.) Plugged filters do not allow air to move freely across the heat exchanger. This is highly inefficient and causes your heating bill to be larger than it should.

2. Inspect the gas pipe running to your furnace for signs of damage.

3. Visually inspect the vent pipe (DO NOT TOUCH IT) to make sure it is securely attached at each section. If the vent pipe is not connected properly, turn your furnace off immediately and make the necessary repairs or call a professional. DO NOT OPERATE YOUR HEATER IF A VENT PROBLEM EXISTS.
