Bidet

These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.

This inspection is designed to detect problems or potential problems that when undetected could cause water damage to your facility.

1. Visually inspect the faucet and sprayer for signs of leaks.
2. Turn cold water on and inspect for leaks, if water is leaking around the faucet handle, repair the leak or call a professional to make the necessary repairs.
3. Turn hot water on and inspect for leaks, if water is leaking around the faucet handle, repair the leak or call a professional to make the necessary repairs.
4. Visually inspect the floor area for signs of leaks
5. Some bidets have a built-in air dry, if your bidet has an air dryer, activate dryer and test for proper air flow and temperature.
