**Clothes Dryer**

*These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.*

This inspection is designed to reduce the chance of fire and to increase the efficiency of the dryer.

1. Inspect the dryer vent hose by removing it from the dryer and the wall. (Most dryer hoses are held in place by a clamp that can be easily released by squeezing the ends together then sliding it up the hose).
2. Take the dryer vent hose outdoors and remove the lint then re-install the hose.
3. Damaged hoses should be replaced as leaks into your living area creates humidity and excess heat. Excess humidity can cause mold and excess heat in the summer can cause your air conditioning equipment to work harder wasting electricity and running up your utility bill.

Note, this inspection often requires someone to move the dryer away from the wall to gain access to the hose.
