Clothes Washer

These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner’s manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.

This inspection is designed to detect water leaks.

1. Inspect water connections for signs of leaks. If water is present on valves or hoses, make necessary repairs as soon as possible.

2. Inspect the drain hose to ensure it is secured inside the drain line.

3. Use a flashlight to check under the washing machine for water. If water exists, you must find the source of the water if possible. If you cannot find the source of water and make the repairs, contact a professional before further damage to your structure is incurred.

Note, Washing machine hoses have similar gaskets to outdoor watering hoses except many of them also have a cone shaped screen to help protect the washer from impurities in the water lines. They are easily replaced. Most home centers carry replacement gaskets and complete hose sets.
