### Computer Power Supply

*These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.*

This inspection is designed to protect your computer and computer equipment. Often, uninterruptible power supplies lose their ability to maintain a charge and you don't know it until the power goes out and you lose your work.

1. Test your uninterruptible power supply (refer to the owner's manual for specific instructions).

Note: Often, uninterruptible power supplies will begin to beep when the batteries are low. When you hear that sound, it may be time to replace the batteries. The sound may have gone off while you were away or out of hearing range. That is why it is important to check your unit at least twice each year.
