Dishwasher

These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner’s manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.

This inspection is designed to detect water leaks which cause structural damage.

1. Remove the kick plate at the bottom of your dishwasher (consult the owner's manual if necessary).
2. Inspect area under dishwasher for signs of water. If water exists, make necessary repairs or call a professional.
3. Re-install the kick plate at the bottom of your dishwasher.

Often dishwasher leaks go undetected for extended periods of time. This is mainly because the leaks are hidden under the washer itself. It only take a couple of minutes to check for leaks and early detection of a leak can save costly repairs.
