Freezer

These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.

This inspection is designed to increase the efficiency of your freezer

1. Pull freezer away from wall and clean under the freezer.

2. Remove dust and lint from condenser coils by using a vacuum cleaner with a hose attachment. (Some condensing coils are on the back of the freezer and others are under the freezer. The bottom cover may need to be removed to gain access, see owners manual for instructions).

3. Push freezer back into its normal location.

Note: Reference your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance tips that are specific to your unit.

Defrosting the freezer also helps conserve energy as the freezer works more efficiently. To defrost your freezer, refer to your owner's manual for specific instructions.

NEVER USE A SHARP OBJECT TO CHIP ICE FROM YOUR FREEZER! One of the best methods we have found to defrost freezers is to remove the contents and place them in a ice chest, unplug the freezer, leave the doors open and let the ice melt. Other items that speed up the melting process include warm water (but this adds to the clean-up) and blow driers which work well by focusing heat on the ice without adding additional water.
