### **Handicap Hand Rails**

*These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.*

This inspection is designed to increase the safety of handicap hand rails.

Hand rails are often found around toilets, bath tubs, and in shower stalls. It is extremely important that these hand rails are secure and capable of functioning as designed under weight.

1. Inspect each hand rail by holding it firmly and applying pressure up and down. It does not take much to tell if the rail is loose and needs tightening. Make the necessary repairs or contact a maintenance professional to ensure the safety of the people who rely on these items.

Note: Handicap hand rails should be maintained in safe working order at all times. If you see a problem during the course of your everyday observations, please make the necessary repairs immediately and do not wait for the formal inspection cycle to roll around again. Safety is everyone's responsibility.
