Ice Maker

These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.

This inspection is designed to increase the efficiency of your icemaker and to inspect for water leaks.

1. Visually inspect the water pipe and fittings attached to your ice maker. If signs of leaks exist, make the necessary repairs or contact a professional.
2. Inspect the drain line attached to the ice bin to insure water is draining properly. If the pipe is obstructed or not draining properly, make the necessary repairs or call a professional.

Note: Ice bins must have functioning drains to be sanitary. Most ice machine drains consist of a piece of pipe or hose that drains into an open floor drain or something similar. Ice machines should not be connected directly to a drain or sewer line.
