Refrigerator

These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner's manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.

This inspection is designed to increase the efficiency of your refrigerator.

1. Pull refrigerator away from wall and clean under the refrigerator.
2. Inspect water supply fittings and pipes for leaks for refrigerators with ice makers.
3. Remove dust and lint from condenser coils by using a vacuum cleaner with a hose attachment. (Some condensing coils are on the back of the refrigerator and others are under the refrigerator and the bottom cover must be removed to gain access, see owners manual for instructions).
4. If your refrigerator has a built in water filter, consider replacing it. Write the date you install each filter on the filter itself with a permanent marker. This will allow you to know exactly when the last filter was installed.

Note: Reference your owner's manual for filter replacement instructions. Frequency of filter replacement is dependant on many factors to include water usage, quality of the water supply, and other variables.
