**Water Purification System**

*These instructions are to be used as a guide to help you maintain your home or office in a safe and efficient manner. They do not replace the requirements of the manufacturer. You should ALWAYS review your owner’s manual for additional preventive maintenance requirements.*

This inspection is required to detect water leaks which could cause damage to your facility and to check the filter system to protect you from using an expired filtration system. Consult the user's manual for specific inspection requirements beyond those listed here.

1. Inspect the water pipes coming into and out of your purification system. If water or corrosion exists, make necessary repairs as soon as possible.
2. Many filters have a visual gauge that indicates the useful life of the filter. If the filter is at the end of its useful life, change filter.

Note: Many under-the-counter filter systems use replaceable filters. Always follow the manufacturer's recommendations for filter changes. Toltek Services recommends that you write the date each new filter is installed on the filter itself in permanent marker. This makes the visual inspection much easier and you always know the age of the filters.
